Use your Joystick Controller with this ATARI Game Program cartridge. For this one-player game, plug the controller cable firmly into the LEFT CONTROLLER jack at the back of your 2600 Video Computer System console. Hold the controller with the red button to your upper left, toward the television screen (See your Owner's Manual for further details).

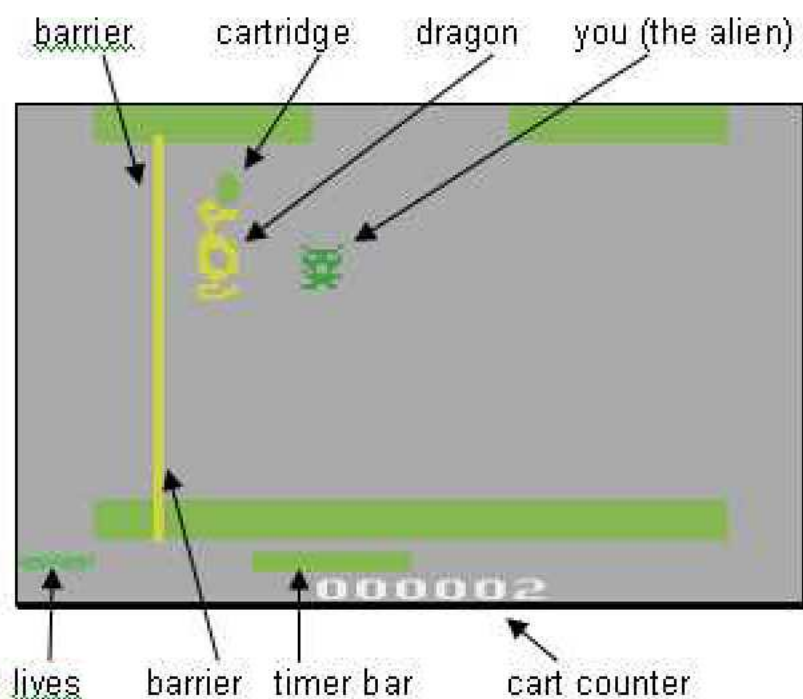
### **YOUR QUEST**

After a two-year rest on your home planet, it is time to find some more Atari 2600 cartridges. It is time to enter a new world!

What your elders failed to tell you is that this new world is filled with vicious, blood-thirsty ducks! OK, they are really dragons, but they sure do look like ducks! These dragons are protecting and defending the Atari 2600 cartridges.

Move your Joystick in the same direction you want to move your alien.

Collect 20 cartridges and a key will appear. Find the key and take it to the gate of the yellow castle and the door will open.



Once inside the castle, you must grab the chalice. Once you have the chalice, it will travel with you. Now, you must throw it at the enemy. That enemy is the character from ADVENTURE, the square. It has been the square's life-long dream to own and protect the chalice. After all, Atari made a whole videogame around it (ADVENTURE). Throw the chalice by pressing the joystick in the direction you want to throw and then press the fire button. It will be hurled in that direction. You must hit the square five times with the chalice. Only then will the square be defeated. Only then will you be able to proceed to the cartridge collecting screen.

## **GAME VARIATIONS**

ALIEN GREED 4 offers two game variations; At the title screen, place the left difficulty switch in the B position to begin a normal game. Place the left difficulty switch in the A position and you will unlock a few more screens for you to explore and your amount of time will be increased as well.

## **THREE LIVES**

Your alien has been granted three lives. Get caught by a dragon and you will lose a life. You only have so many seconds to find a cartridge. There is a timer bar, which is visible right above your cartridge counter (score). If you run out of time, you will lose a life. One way to replenish your timer bar is to find a cartridge. Keep finding cartridges and you will have plenty of time. When time is close to running out, you will hear an audible sound that warns you. Find a cartridge! Be careful! Be quick! You can see how many lives your alien has left at any time. The lives are represented by the small green aliens pictured in the lower left hand side of the screen.

## **SCORING**

ALIEN GREED 4 is a race against the clock. You will receive one point for each cartridge you collect. Keep collecting cartridges and save yourself from running out of time and losing all your lives. Once your three lives are gone, the game is over.

## **COME, LET'S DO IT AGAIN!**

Defeat the square and you will be returned to the cartridge collecting screen where it all began. However, you may find it more difficult to do it again. Good luck!

So you think you got what it takes? Collect 80 cartridges and take a picture of your screen. Send it to us and you will receive a patch and you will be an official member of the ELITE ALIEN ARMY.

## **TIPS and TRICKS**

If the dragon gets a hold of you, there is hope to escape from his clutches: Quickly push your joystick back and forth to the left and to the right and you may break free from his grasp.
