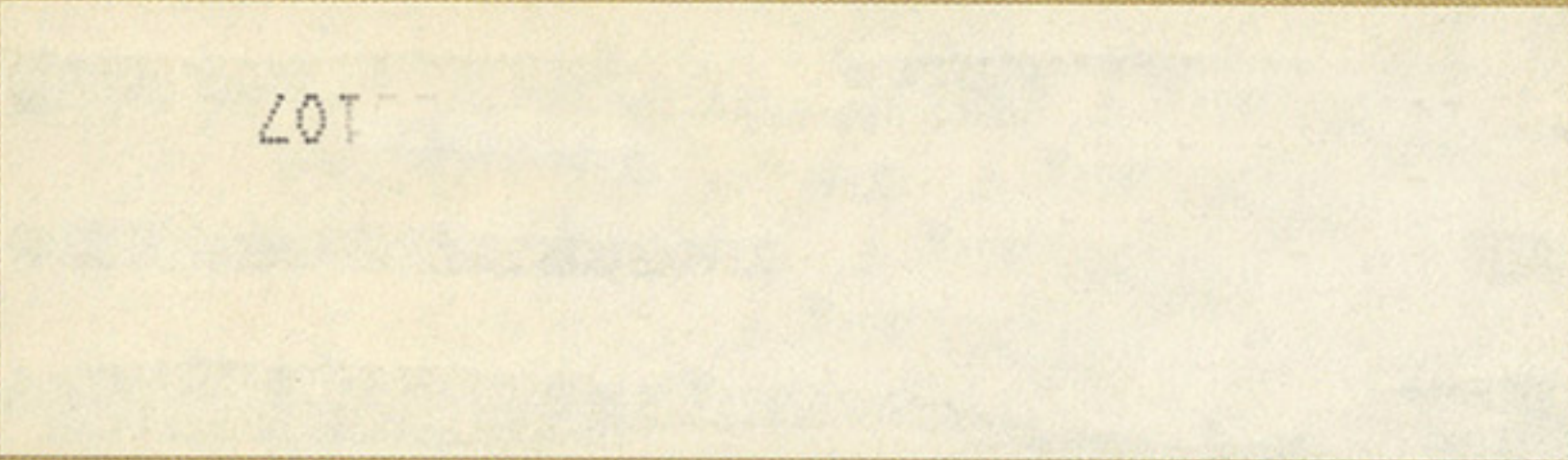

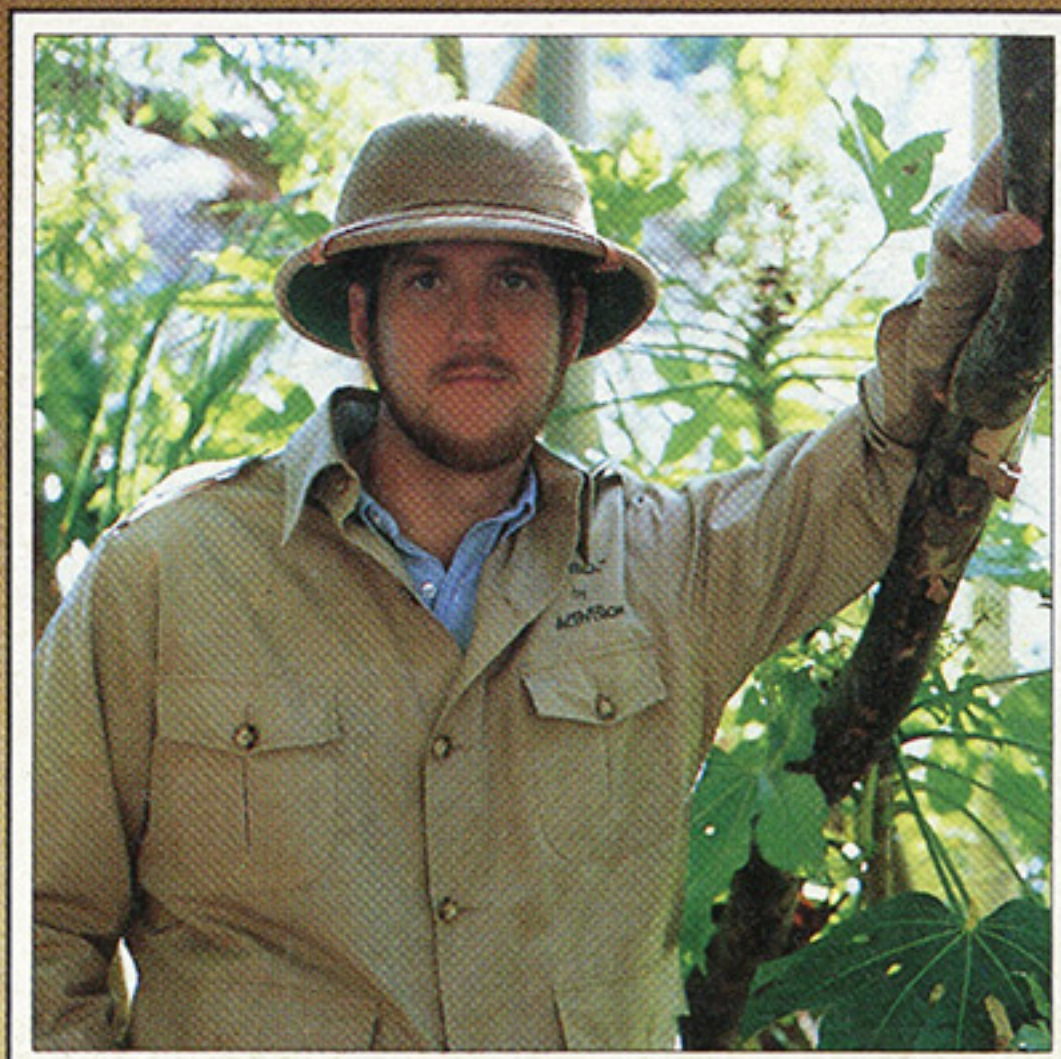

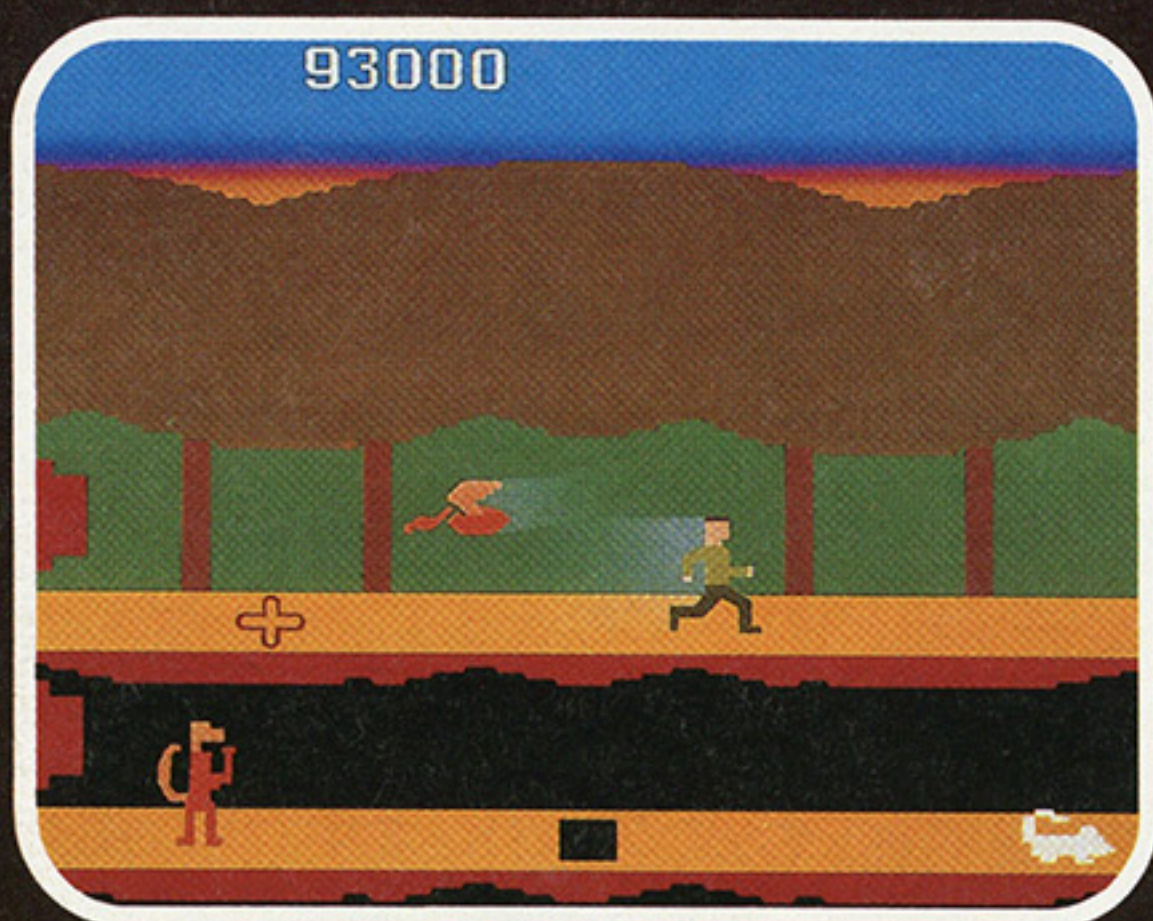
We last left Pitfall Harry swinging through the world's deepest jungles. But now you and he are headed for even deeper adventure: the Lost Caverns of the Incas.

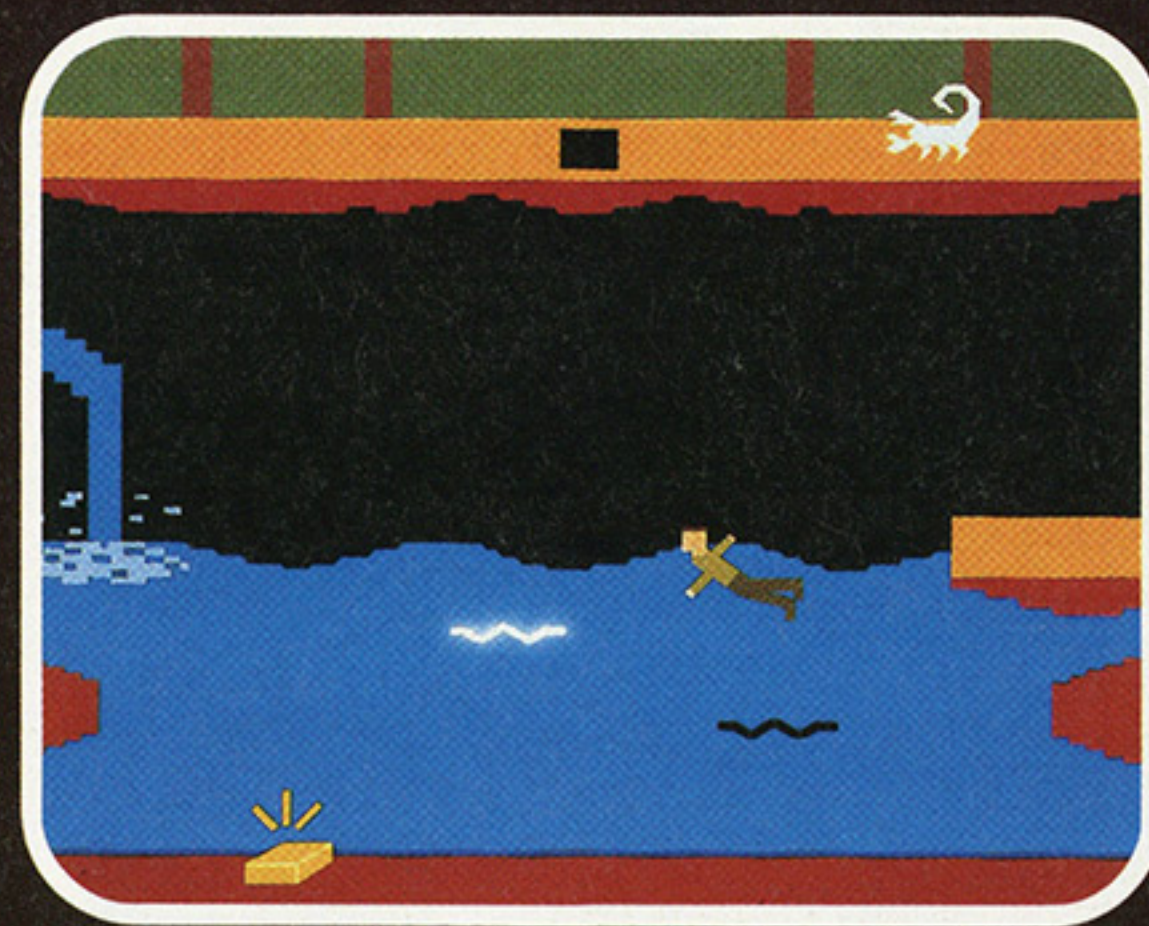
High adventure? Hundreds of towering cliffhanging ledges. Blind leaps across bottomless voids. Pitfall II heightens the meaning of the word vertigo.

Excitement? See for yourself.



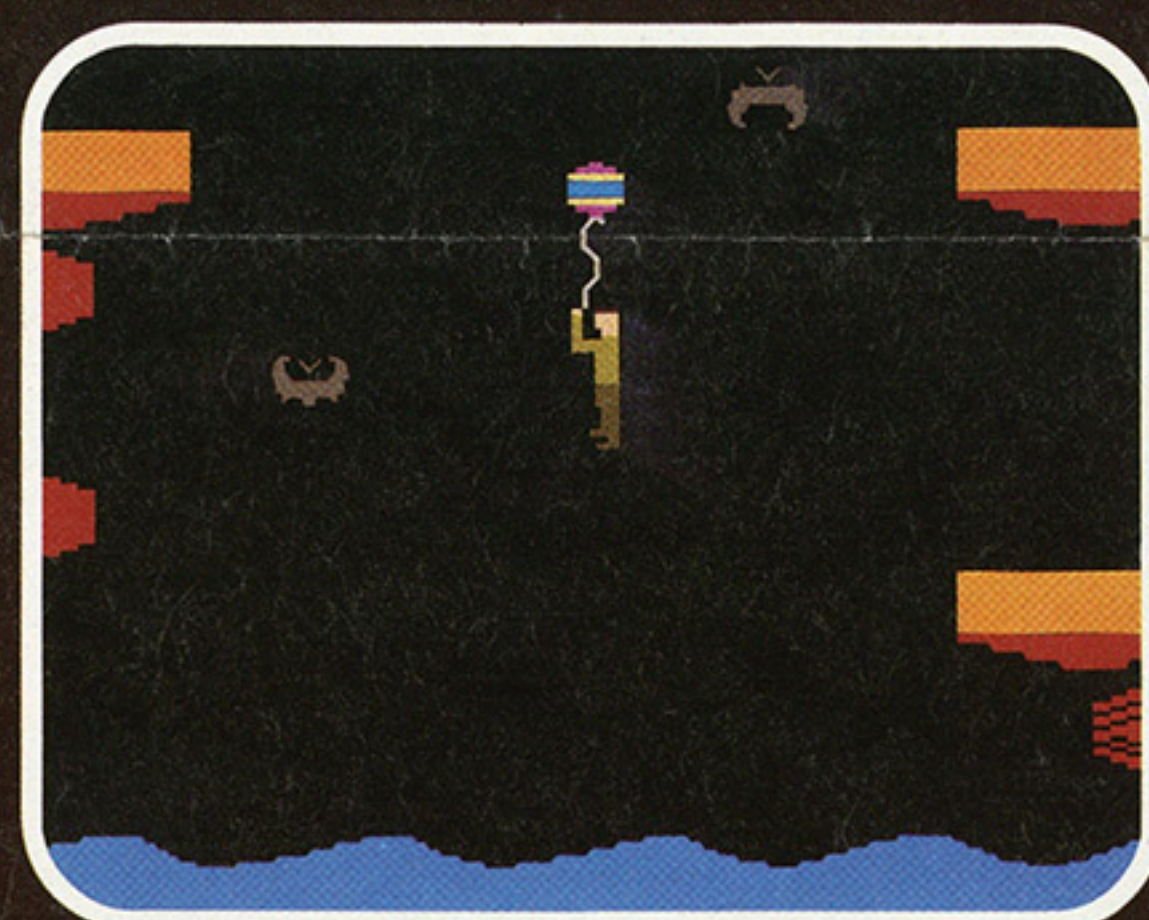

→ Pitfall Harry, wearing the latest in swim fashion, cascades down a waterfall into a raging river filled with electric eels. Nobody said finding gold would be easy (at least they're not piranha). Note the irritable scorpion with the lousy suntan.



← Enjoying the vacation of a lifetime, Pitfall Harry is shown here playing tag with some friends—carnivorous condors, poisonous frogs, a cave bat or two. 216 unromantic caves, connected by ladders and long jumps. Wish you were here.

→ Helium / 'he-le-əm / n.: a light colorless gaseous element used chiefly for inflating airships and brightly-colored balloons so that Pitfall Harry can rise to the occasion. Steering the balloon into a cave bat, it pops and Pitfall Harry lands on higher ground. Ta-da.
