# The CES Where Games Begin!!

Twice a year the electronics industry holds a convention to display its new products. The Winter Consumer Electronics Show is held in January in Las Vegas and the Summer Consumer Electronics Show is held in June in Chicago. We just returned from the Las

Vegas show and have lots to report on.

The most important factor to come out of this show was the number of different manufacturers producing cartridges for the Atari and Intellivision Units, Last year, as you probably know, a company called Activision, made up of four engineers who left Atari to form their own company, became the first to produce cartridges for the Atari Unit. Once other companies and individuals realized that they

too could make cartridges, the door

was opened for great things. In addition to Atari, Intellivision and Activision there are four other companies making cartridges and I'm sure there will be more.

You can look forward to 1982 being the year the arcade games come home. It seems that each manufacturer is trying to outdo the other by buying the rights to commercial arcade games and producing them in cartridges for the Atari and/or Intellivision.



### Arcade Games in '82 Atari/Intellivision

Coleco has bought the rights to 6 popular arcade games, among them **DONKEY KONG** and **PHOENIX**. They are planning to produce all their cartridges in both Atari and Intellivision format. Their games will not be shipped until 3rd Quarter 1982. More information about these cartridges will be in subsequent newsletters.

IMAGIC is another new company comprised of ex-

Atari and ex-Intellivision engineers who are designing cartridges for both Atari and Intellivision. The three announced Imagic cartridges for Atari are

DEMON ATTACK, STAR VOYAGER and TRICK

SHOT, Demon Attack looks like

Phoenix and has great graphics and play appeal. Star Voyager is a space game where you cruise through a star gate trying

to clear a star path to get into the sector beyond. Trick Shot is a pool game where you can bank shots and hustle your opponent. Coming soon from Imagic for Intellivision is a dungeons and dragons type game where you are looking for precious jewels in an endless castle white warding off bloodthirsty demons. Juring trolls and cave monsters. This cartridge was unavailable for previewing. IMAGIC plans to have 8 Atari cartridges and 4 Intellivision cartridges available by June 1982.

U.S. Games corporation is another new company that will be producing cartridges. As of now they only have plans to produce cartridges for the Atari Unit. The first 2 to be released are SPACE JOCKEY and HIDE & SEEK. Space Jockey is a Defender-type game where a space ship is shooting at objects that go across the screen. Hide and Seek was unavailable for viewing. Both these cartridges are slated to be shipped in Feb./Mar.

Computer Magic, the company who is making the MAGIC CARD for the Atari Unit, is in the process of making 2 more cartridges for the Atari and possibly a MAGIC CARD for the Intellivision Unit.

# G.A.M.E.S. is The Place For All Games Odyssey 2 Now For Sale!

We are presently planning to carry **ODYSSEY-2** in all of our stores. Hopefully by the time you received this letter we will have sufficient stock in all our stores. Aside from the 40+ cartridges that are currently available for the Odyssey-2 Unit, they are coming out with a very clever set of games. They call them the Master Strategy Series and the first game is "The Quest For The Rings." This marks the beginning of a highly advanced era in video game systems. Players combine gameboard strategy with on-screen video action through the use of the computer keyboard. Another exciting plan for the Odyssey-2 is the voice and sound module. This will be available this summer.

Many people ask us which unit is the best. There is no one answer to this question. While each unit is good, they each seem to excel in one particular area. It is our opinion that the Atari is best for arcade games, Intellivision is best for sports games and Odyssey is best for strategy games. Believe it or not, many people buy all three!

Intellivision
in '82

Intellivision is planning lots of new cartridges for 1982. The first to be released will be STAR STRIKE. You're flying a rocket-powered fighter-interceptor trying to save the Earth from alien rocket-craft. It's a one player game with six skill

levels. This cartridge was released in limited supply in January. **FROG BOG** lets you control a frog sitting on a lily pad. You score points when he catches flies on his tongue. This is a one or two player game. Frog Bog should be available in March. Later this year Intellivision is adding a speech synthesis module to the unit which plugs in to the cartridge slot and then a cartridge plugs in which will add the dimension of speech to the cartridges. The 3 cartridges that have been announced are Space Spartans, Bomb Squad and B-17 Bomber. All three are great action games with the added thrill of speech.


